**1ST SUNDAY OF LENT****FEBRUARY 21, 2010****REFLECTIONS****Good News!****February 21**

One of the most important people in my life is a teacher. She's retired now. For several years I was her student. Later I was privileged to work with her as a colleague. She was a world traveler. Each summer her religious order would send her somewhere exotic—an international ecclesial meeting in Africa, a conference for women in the Church in Asia.

Each fall I would talk to her in the copying room: "Where have you been?" I wanted to live vicariously through her travels. I also wanted to know about whom she'd met, what she'd learned, what talks she'd given. She went to Hong Kong on one trip because she was already going to Korea. She was in the neighborhood, so why not? Sister D had a big neighborhood.

She introduced me to her kindred spirit, Egeria. You've heard of the Church Fathers, like Augustine, Ambrose, Gregory of Nyssa? She had us read all of them. She also had us read the Church Mother, Egeria. Probably from the late fourth century, her *Travels*, or at least big chunks of it, was lost for several centuries until it resurfaced in the late 1800s. Egeria came from the West and toured the Holy Land, writing about Christian customs, observing, interviewing, interacting, and pollinating the greater Church with tales from her journeys.

Egeria has vivid descriptions of different Lenten practices in Jerusalem. Some fasted for a day. Some took one meal. Some fasted the whole week, eating only on Sunday and Saturday. She has an interesting observation on the diverse practices: each person does what he or she can; no one is criticized or praised for his or her particulars (*Travels*, 28:1-3).

The communion of saints offers us a rich collection of fellow travelers becoming Christlike, and more than a few characters.

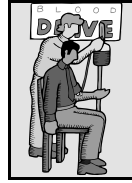

- ✚ To be acquainted with the breadth of St. Francis of Assisi services so as to be able to quickly connect EC members with those services. Listen for EC member needs and proactively offer parish resources.

**Current Church Regulations on Fasting and Abstinence**

- ✚ Fasting is required of all Catholics age 18-59 only two days each year: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (it is recommended that the Good Friday fast carry over to Holy Saturday until the Easter Vigil service, as well).
- ✚ On these days only one full meal is allowed, with two smaller meals as needed.
- ✚ Eating solid food between meals is not allowed.
- ✚ Abstinence from meat is required of all Catholics over age 14 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- ✚ In the United States, the bishops have asked Catholics over the age of 14 to abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent, as well.

These regulations are considered to be a serious obligation for all Catholics. However, those who are ill, pregnant, on medication or special diets for health concerns, or those who must work at extremely physical jobs may be exempt from these regulations.
