7TH SUNDAY OF EASTER**MAY 16, 2010****REFLECTIONS****Good News!****May 16***[I pray] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him (Ephesians 1:17).*

I saw this happen once.

My friend Monique was in the hospital. She wasn't in her room when I visited her. I waited, and then I heard an announcement that a prayer meeting was about to start. I guessed she'd gone to the chapel, so I went to join her.

Monique wasn't there, but I stayed, expecting to see her and thinking I could pray for her and the other people gathered. While waiting, I talked to another patient who sat next to me. She told me she knew she'd die in the next day or so.

I was stunned by the calm way she described what she saw ahead. She had a look—a peace—on her face that I can only describe with the words Saint Stephen used in Acts 7:55: "filled with the holy Spirit, [he] looked up intently to heaven and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God." That gaze—Stephen's gaze—was what I saw in this woman's eyes.

As I sat and prayed with her, the grace she lived in invited me to say something I'd never said to anyone else. "When you're in heaven, say hello to my mother." I didn't feel strange or maudlin or silly. In a matter-of-fact way, I knew the message would be delivered.

This woman, whose name I can't remember, became a simple, powerful teacher in my life, though I only talked to her once (in this life). She lived in the wisdom and revelation of Christ, and through her, Christ connected me to the communion of saints.

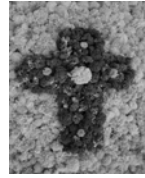

Two Filipino cross-cultural activities annually celebrated at our parish during the month of May are the *Flores de Mayo* (Flowers of May) and the *Santacruzán* (Festival of the Holy Cross). These are several of the many cross-cultural events that make St. Francis a special place of worship.

The Flores de Mayo is an offering of flowers during the entire month as a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and is celebrated in various ways in different parts of the Philippines. Here in our parish, flowers are brought as part of the celebration of Mass and the image of Mary is bedecked with these flowers for the entire month of May. The Santacruzán, on the other hand, is a historical commemoration of the discovery of the Holy Cross by Queen Helena, mother of Constantine the Great, the Roman emperor who converted to Catholicism. The Santacruzán is a colorful procession with young ladies and their escorts parade under colorful arches of flowers, as praises to the Blessed Virgin Mary are sung.

Mark your calendars now, as the St. Francis celebration of Santacruzán is scheduled for **May 23rd beginning at 5:00pm** with a living rosary and the Santacruzán procession to be followed immediately by the 6pm Youth Mass.
