**REFLECTIONS**

**Good News!**  
**May 23**

*See that corner? From there take the 571 bus and go two stops past the Coliseum. You' ll see Saint Clement' s. Pay the three Euros and go down-stairs. It' s amazing.*

With just a day and a half left in Rome, we had lunch with a friend. From his balcony we looked into Saint Peter' s Square, where we had stood just an hour before and heard Pope Benedict speak. Our friend, teaching early-Church history in Rome, had visited a hundred churches in the city. We didn' t have time for that many, so we asked him to recommend a couple. San Clemente was his top choice.

We walked through an eighteenth-century facade into a twelfth-century courtyard. The current building was created over the filled-in space of a medieval church that originally dated back to the fourth century. And below *that* spot are the remains of a first-century building and a Mithraic temple. The sense in Rome in general, and in this church in particular, is of walking through history. Even further below Saint Clement' s are remnants of buildings destroyed by the emperor Nero' s fire in the year 64.

It all started at Pentecost. The apostles—Peter who preached on that first day and Paul who carried the Gospel all over the Mediterranean—gave their lives in Rome. All over Rome are the reminders of the challenges the Church faced as it moved through the centuries. All over Europe and on each continent the message of Christ traveled, carried by human voices and human hands. All have heard in their “own tongues of the mighty acts of God.”

Great challenges face the Church in the world today. But the roots of our faith are deep. The Spirit moves through every layer, down every path, with and in us.

Rev. Normandy V. Segovia,  
Parochial Vicar  
Rev. Normandy Segovia was born and raised in Bacolod City, Negros Occidental Province, Philippines. People used to call him "Chady". He is the eldest son of two children. Fr. Chady finished his elementary and high school years in Victorias City. Immediately after High school, he entered the seminary and began his priestly formation at Sacred Heart Seminary. In 1996, he graduated from college earning a degree, Bachelor of Arts major in Philosophy. After his first year of theologate, he took a year off from seminary program. He worked as a high school teacher at St. Rose of Lima School. Aside from teaching history and religion class, he was assigned as religious coordinator, and music director of the school. After a year, he decided to continue his seminary formation at St. Vincent School of Theology in Manila. In 2001 he was accepted by the Diocese of San José, and came to the United States to continue his priestly formation. In 2006, he graduated from St. Patrick's Seminary and University with a MDiv and STB degrees.

He was ordained to the priesthood in June 3, 2006 by Bishop Patrick McGrath, Bishop of San José. St. Joseph of Cupertino is his first assignment as parochial vicar.

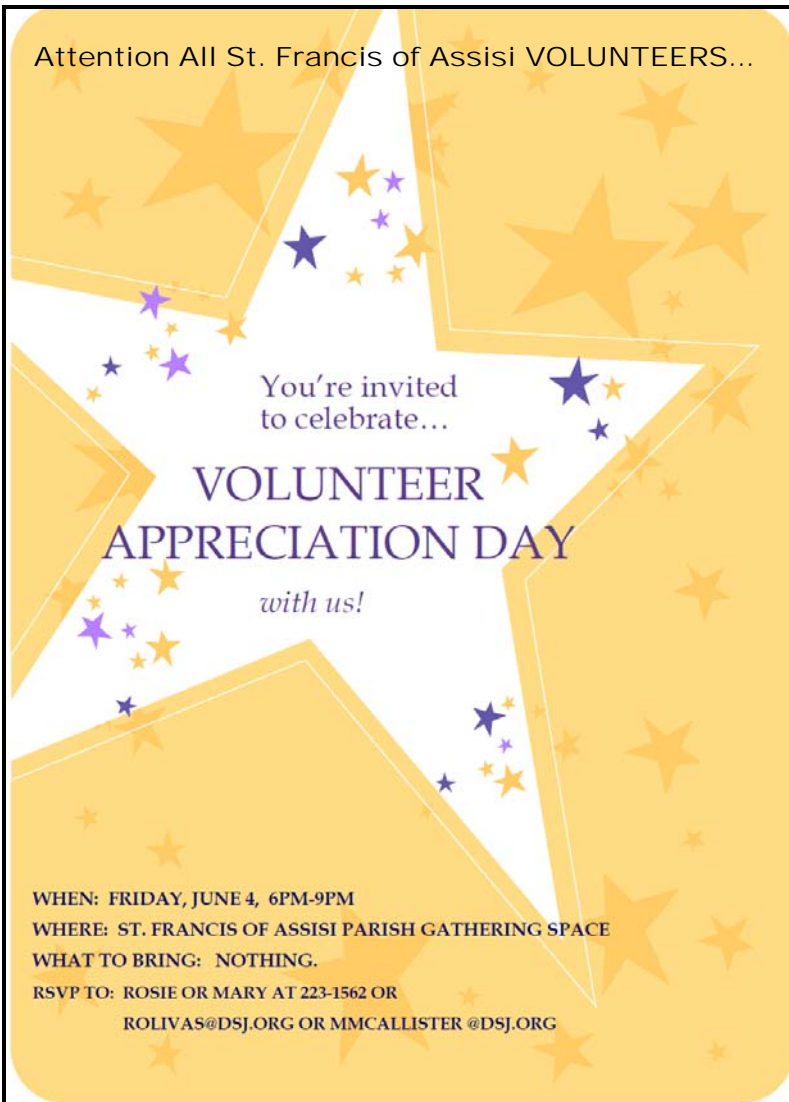
